Youth Development Centre

The Development Centre is specifically for the Under 5's, Under 6's and 7's. It aims to introduce young children to football, providing them with core skills and the ability to work within a team. It is growing on a weekly basis and is proving to be very popular club for our youngsters.

If your child falls within this age group please be advised that he or she must be properly checked in and out by ourselves every week. This is for your child's safety and to ensure we follow club protocol.



Training at the centre is £4.00 per week and therefore £16.00 payable a month in advance. Training starts promptly at 9.00am and finishes at 10.15am.

Please ensure you arrive in sufficient time to allow your child to be checked in. Our Development Centre Rep will be responsible for collecting the training fees as well as the checking in/out of your child.

If you are unable to attend please can you let us know in advance if possible or on the day so we can advise the relevant coaches.

Should the weather conditions be extreme, we will contact you via text to advise you that the Development Centre training has been cancelled. Please ensure that we have all your details so we can communicate with you.
